



# A GREAT WAVE OF ENTHUSIASM

Republicans are Awake to the Fact That a Great Campaign is Being Waged.

## BIG MEETINGS HELD

Grosvenor at Adelphi, Clarksburg and Frankfort—Mr. White Here This Evening.

Gen. Grosvenor's visit to Adelphi yesterday evening was made under most auspicious circumstances. The little town was filled to overflowing with those who had been attracted by the coming of the Republican candidate for Congress and there was a feeling of victory in the air.

The Adelphi brass band rendered sweet music for the occasion and the hall was well filled to hear the speaker. Col. John C. Entekin opened the meeting with some appropriate remarks on the condition of the country to-day and compared it with four years ago and he was followed by General Grosvenor, who paid attention to the fallacies Bryan has been expounding in the past few days and in doing so he battered the great wall of imperialism which Bryan has reared to scare the people of the country, as well as the imperialism which exists only in the imagery of a disordered brain. He also paid some attention to the trust question and referred to the great number of so called trusts which were headed by the leading Democrats, men who themselves had helped to frame the anti-trust resolution of the Popocratic platform, which is masquerading as a Democratic principle or set of principles and of the failure of the Democrats to legislate against or prosecute the trusts.

Gen. Grosvenor held the attention of his audience until the very end. It was indeed a most successful meeting and one which will bear good fruit for the Republican party on election day.

This evening and this afternoon Gen. Grosvenor and a number of other speakers will address the people of Clarksburg. A great crowd is assembling at Clarksburg and one of the grandest meetings in the county will be held there and at Frankfort this evening. One hundred and fifty rough riders left Frankfort this afternoon to take part in the Clarksburg proceedings and fully that number of rough riders will join the great walk around from Clarksburg to Frankfort, which will be made this evening with torch lights burning and a grand wave of Republican enthusiasm, bringing the people who believe in the honor of the country, its financial welfare and integrity into harmony with grand success on election.
