52 Bands, 2,865 Musicians To Play during 4-Day Show

Fifty-two bands will provide the ever-present music for the 52nd annual Pumpkin Show which starts Wednesday.

The 52 bands will bring 2,865 musicians to Circleville, along with 275 drum majors and majorettes.

The Jackson High School Band will be the largest band to attend, bringing with it 110 members. Ashville, Columbus South and Washington C. H. follow Jackson with bands having 107, 103 and 100 members.

The bands with the most Drum Majors and Majorettes are Thurston and West Hocking Local. Each has 11. Right on their heels are Rushville, Chillicothe, and Washington C. H. with 10 each.

The Thursday night parade will be the biggest band parade, with 14 Bands, and 5 Drum and Bugle Corps.

THE CIRCLEVILLE High School Band will make the most appearances of any musical unit, marching in six parades. The Yellowbud Community Band will march in three parades, and the Circleville Drum and Bugle Corps, and the Adelphi Community Band will march in two parades each.

The most outstanding musical unit to appear during the Pumpkin Show which is not figured in

the statistics shown above is the United States Air Force Drum and Bugle Corps.

This outstanding unit will present a 35-minute performance each night of the Pumpkin Show at the Circleville High School Football field. The time of each performance is 7:15 p. m.

The Pumpkin Show Directors have secured, from the Ohio State Fair, Shuttle Buses, to operate from the Circleville Postoffice, to the Football Field each evening of the Pumpkin Show, from 6:45 to 7:15 p. m. in order that those who do not care to walk to see the Air Force Unit may ride. The same transportation will be provided back uptown after the performance in order that all may see the parades which are scheduled to start at 8 p. m.

Several new bands, which have never been to a Pumpkin Show, have been secured this year. They are 338th Army Band, Army Reserve, Ft. Hayes, Columbus; Upper Arlington High School Band, Chillicothe High School Band, Columbus East High School, Corning, and Licking Valley (Hanover).
