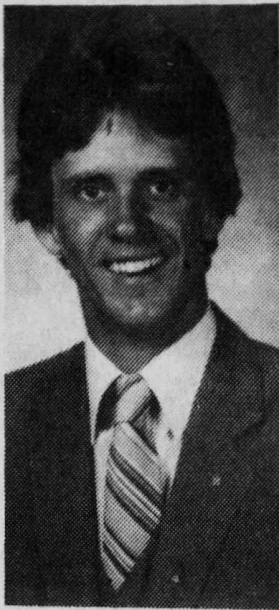

Channell To Play In National FFA Band Next Month

Clark W. Channell of Amanda, has been selected as one of Future Farmers of America's official music makers in the National FFA Band. The 80-member band will be featured at the organization's 55th National FFA Convention, Nov. 11-13, in Kansas City, Missouri.

Channell is a member of the Pickaway-Ross FFA Chapter. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Elden Channell, 617 N. School St, Amanda, 43102.

FFA Band members were nominated by their state associations and final selection was made from more than 400 applications. The young musicians will travel to Kansas City three days prior to start of the convention practice, then will take to the stage and provide

entertainment for FFA members and guests during the convention proceedings.

The National FFA Band is directed by Roger Heath, formerly Band Director at Virginia Tech and California Polytechnic Institute. The band's operation is sponsored by the Carnation Company of Los Angeles, California, as a special project of the National FFA Foundation.

Clark is a senior at Pickaway Ross Vocational School where he is studying Horticulture and Landscaping. He is also a member of First United Methodist Church and Fairfield Chapter Order of DeMolay. Clark is also a former member of the Blue Lancers Drum and Baton Corps and the Adelphi Band.
