BAND SCHEDULE DETAILED

Foresman Chimes To Open Show's Musical Program

Circleville Pumpkin Show will be opened this year with the playing of the Foresman Chimes in the tower of Pickaway Courthouse at 2 p. m. Wednesday.

This will be followed with an address to the crowd by the Rev. Fr. Edward J. Reidy. He will be introduced by Program Director James P. Shea.

A welcoming speech will be given next by Circleville Mayor Thurman L. Miller, followed by playing of the national anthem by Amanda high school band.

According to George K. Fishpaw, director of parades and music, the schedule of bands for the rest of the Pumpkin Show will be as follows:

Wednesday: Amanda, Bremen and Circleville high school bands. All three will appear in the Beauty Parade Wednesday evening.

Pickaway and Circleville high schools in a parade at 2 p. m. These two bands will also participate in the parade of veterans organizations musical units at 8:30 p. m. Competing units entered are:

Drum and Bugle Corps of Legion Post 144, Columbus; Drum and Bugle Corps of Legion Post 73, Bellefontaine; Drum and Bugle Corps of Legion Post 266, Belle Center; band from Legion Post 69, Reading; Fife and Drum Corps from Jackson and Drum and Bugle Corps of VFW Post 1031, Springfield. Circleville Drum and Bugle Corps will also participate, but will not compete for prizes.

Friday: Pickerington high school at 1 p. m., Pickaway Township and Circleville high schools in the Baby Parade at 2 p. m.

Carroll, Rushville, Ashville, Stoutsville, Pickaway Township, Walnut Township and Williamsport, high school bands, Circleville Legion Drum and Bugle Corps, Columbus Moose band, and Columbus VFW Negro Drum and Bugle Corps will appear Friday night.

Saturday: MacArthur and Union Furnace high school bands and Hallsville-Adelphi city band.
