## 65th Pumpkin Show Ready; Miss America Due Thursday

CIRCLEVILLE — The accent is on beauty for the 65th annual Pumpkin Show which will officially open at 2 p.m. Wednesday with the playing of the Foresman Chimas in the Pickaway County Courthouse tower.

Miss America 1971, Larue Lea Schaefer of Bexley, will be on hand Thursday marking the first time a reigning Miss America has ever visited the Pumpkin Show.

During the four-day festival a total of 56 bands will march in the seven parades. There are 3,549 musicians in the combined bands. The Circleville High School band, a 143-member marching unit, traditionally leads all parades and the junior high band consisting of 275 pieces will be the largest band.

OTHERS in the parade will be the 140-member Miami Trace marching band, the Adelphi Community Band, Groveport - Madison, Fairfield, Nelsonville - York and Lemon Monroe bands.

The first big event comes just

an hour after the opening ceremonies. It is the little Miss Pumpkin Show parade and judging. Then comes the Pumpkin Show Parade and competition.

Free acts and band concerts will be held throughout the day. The big parades Friday are the Pet Parade and Parade of Fraternal organizations and civic clubs.

Saturday the Ohio Festival Queens parade will be held. Other traditional Saturday events include the pie-eating contest, baton twirling contest and hog-calling contest.

A crowd in excess of 100,000 is expected to jam the four-square downtown area.
