Rain washes out Pumpkin parades

CIRCLEVILLE — Rain inundated the
Circleville Pumpkin Show Thursday.

For the first time since Friday of the
1975 festival, rain wiped out two parades in
one day.

Rain began before dawn Thursday and
continued until after dark in a steady
shower that wiped out the Baby Parade,
the Parade of Bands and the Zane Trace
Band Concert.

Finding a place to park was not difficult
as people who were brave enough to venture
outdoors made the most of it.

Festival announcer Terry Agin and a
passerby on his way to work both expressed
amazement at finding carnival rides
full of people in the rain.

Circleville Mayor John Jenkins said the
rain did not deter several of his fellow

mayors from other cities visiting the show
and participating in a Pumpkin Pat Open
at the Fox Fire Golf course in the after-
noon.

Today's highlights are the Pet and Anti-
que Car Parade at 3 p.m., Joe Waters and
the Appalachia Band at 6 and the parade of
Fraternal and Civic organizations at 8.

Saturday's activities begin with the
Pumpkin Show 5-mile run at Circleville
High School at 9:30 a.m. The Pumpkin Pie
Eating Contest begins at 4 p.m., the Hog
