Cantata auditions Friday

Auditions for choral and chamber orchestral parts of a Bach Christmas cantata, "For Us a Child is Born," will be held at St. Paul's Episcopal Church Friday.

Audition time can be scheduled by contacting either Mrs. John Herlihy or Mrs. F. Allyn Walker.

The cantata is scheduled for performance at the local Episcopal church, Dec. 21. Rehearsals, scheduled for each Sunday prior to the concert, will begin at 2:30 p.m. Nov. 2.

Pieces needed for the chamber orchestra include two flutes, two oboes, two violins, a cello, viola and a string bass.

The Adelphi Band will present a concert on the courthouse one-half hour before parade time.

The Antique Auto Club of Southern Ohio will provide cars for the mayors and the parade marshal, and will have several other autos in the parade.
