

LARGE THROG ARRIVES EARLY TO CELEBRATE

Four Parades Are Chief At-
tractions of Pumpkin
Show Last Two Days.

BANDS PLEASING

Pet and Industrial Parades
Are Saturday Afternoon.

With a bright sun shining upon the city, crowds of Pumpkin Show visitors began to throng into the city early Friday morning and early this afternoon a truly large Pumpkin Show crowd was on the streets to view the two big parades of the afternoon the third parade this evening. The first ideal Pumpkin Show day of the week found its way into the city Friday and people from far and wide were wending their ways here to take part in the remaining two days of the celebration.

Beginning at 1:30 p. m. Friday when the baby parade, postponed from Thursday afternoon because of rain, was the leading event, until late Saturday night the Pumpkin Show will be celebrated in its usual way.

PARADE FEATURES

Immediately following the baby parade, the industrial and automobile parade with many beautiful floats in the line of march was scheduled. The comic and characterization parade with a large number of entrants was set for Friday at 8 p. m.

All three of these parades create much interest each year and were in a large way responsible for the large Friday afternoon crowd. It was expected that Friday evening's crowd would be a great one.

The Ashville community band and the Adelphi band were playing their brilliant music Friday beginning early in the morning and continuing through the day and Friday evening the American Legion drum corps, which has created such a good impression with its tunes during the first two days of the show, is again scheduled. Thursday evening the Chillicothe drummers came to town and paraded with the local organization. The combined music was excellent.

Saturday afternoon the favorite event of the entire show, the pet parade, will be seen at 2:30 o'clock. Children from Circleville and from every city, town, village and hamlet in the county and adjoining counties will be present to see other kiddies marching up and down the streets with their galaxy of pets. Last year's pet parade was one of the most complete a Pumpkin Show ever saw and this year's is expected to be every bit as good. One child last year had six pets in one wagon and naturally walked off with the major prize.

The pet parade will start at Pinckney-st and will proceed south on Scioto to Main, east on Main to Pickaway, south on Pickaway to Franklin, west on Franklin to Court, north on Court to Pinckney, where judging will be done.

MERCHANTS BUSY

The industrial and automobile parade staged immediately after the pet parade promises to be a real event for many merchants and manufactures are making entries.

The industrial parade Saturday afternoon will be the last of these events.

If Saturday is as fine a day as Friday it is possible a record for attendance will be made.
