Senator Glenn terms inflation top issue

Senator John Glenn and local
Democrats rallied behind Ted Strickland,
Democratic candidate for sixth district
congressman, at a pre-election rally
Monday night at Chillicothe High School.
Glenn cited inflation as the main issue
facing voters on a national level.
He said inflation was not just a federal
problem, state government has tripled in
the last decade. Glenn added he had
