# Senator Glenn terms inflation top issue

Senator John Glenn and local Democrats rallied behind Ted Strickland, Democratic candidate for sixth district congressman, at a pre-election rally Monday night at Chillicothe High School.

Glenn cited inflation as the main issue facing voters on a national level.

He said inflation was not just a federal problem, state government has tripled in the last decade. Glenn added he had talked with the entire state Democratic ticket about inflation and ways to control it on the state level.

Approximately 100 persons were in the high school gymnasium to listen to the democratic candidates endorse Strickland. The Adelphi Community Band played marches for the event.

Glenn said the U.S. House of Representatives needed "more good, bright, young people like Ted who know the problems at home."

Strickland said he had spent every day since February crisscrossing the sixth district to find out what the voters wanted. "I don't think (Rep. William) Harsha is qualified to represent us; he's too complacent, too tied to special interests," Strickland said.

He added he rejected the label of liberal and preferred to call himself a "compassionate realist."
