

PUMPKIN SHOW SUCCESS EVEN BEYOND IDEAS

27th Annual Show To Be Completed Tonight With Great Throng In City.

BANDS SHOW PEP

Parades Win Approval of All Spectators Friday.

Circleville's 27th annual Pumpkin Show will come to a close at midnight tonight and drawing conclusions from the great crowd which swarmed the city early Saturday morning, this is going to be the gala day of the entire Pumpkin Show. A bright sun threw its rays upon the city beginning early in the day and with the air just cool enough to keep people moving, residents from all central Ohio were enjoying the displays which lined streets for several blocks from the public square.

With the pet parade and the industrial parade climaxing the show during the afternoon the citizenry turned to the free attractions and displays for entertainment during the evening.

FRIDAY CROWD GREAT

Friday's crowd was an exceptionally large one for Friday and everyone was more than satisfied with the three parades which were events of this day. The baby parade early in the afternoon; the industrial parade following that and the comic and characterization parade completing the events in the evening were fine features of the Pumpkin Show and drew approval of the entire line of spectators.

Although prizes could not be awarded in the industrial parade until after the second procession, the feature of Saturday afternoon, the populace after watching the Friday parade, drew its own conclusions as to which floats should be awarded the top prizes. Some of the floats in this parade were marvelous. Bright colors, perfect trimmings and everything that goes to make a parade a real thing could be seen in this event with only a few of the entries outstanding.

The industrial parade this afternoon was scheduled for 3 o'clock, with the pet parade preceding it just one-half hour.

THREE BANDS ACTIVE

The Adelphi band, the Ashville community band and the Laurelville band were blaring their music up and down the streets in true Pumpkin Show fashion. All the bands seemed to be possessed of the fact that today is the final day of the big celebration of the Pumpkin Show and were doing their best to make everyone feel the same way.

Never before has so much favorable criticism been heard concerning the displays. With the drouth during the entire summer and nearly everyone complaining that there would be no displays worth seeing many persons were decidedly against having a Pumpkin Show. But since the displays have been placed on the streets, since many of those who criticized have not turned the other way, the directors of the Pumpkin Show are more than satisfied with results.
