THE unexpected death of Will Huff was a shock to many, who recall with more than a touch of nostalgia, those quiet peaceful Sundays of yore when community band concerts were the attraction that lured thousands weekly to Yoctangee park during the summer months.

Will Huff became a leading figure in the musical organizations, whose melodies, whether heard from a drifting boat on the placid lake that once was a distinctive feature of the park, or from a first row bench next the bandstand, always were soul filling.

Mr. Huff liked band music. He organized the old IOOF band, which took over when the original 20th Century band passed out of existence, and wrote many of the marches which distinguished its repertoire.

Chillicothe misses those good old days; it bows its head in silent tribute to Will Huff and the memories his passing evokes.
