I wanted to take a moment to share some news. Jeff Mathew and I recently had lunch, and I wanted to let you all know that I'm stepping up to take the reins and ensure our band continues to make music, and hopefully, flourishes. Jeff has agreed in the near term to continue some behind the scenes orchestration of performances, etc., as I get my bearings and I want to thank him for all the guidance he's provided. I do want to mention that I'm not a seasoned conductor. By that I mean the only time I've ever conducted was in a course in college. So, be prepared for an interesting experience in that regard. However, to the extent that I conduct, I plan to continue Jeff's tradition of counting off and playing, so the transition should be relatively smooth.

For those of you I haven't had the chance to chat with recently, here's a bit about me: I'm 39 years old, I live on the north side of Circleville with my wife, Jesseca, and our three children, aged 3, 5, and 8. I'm a Circleville High School alum, and I have a degree in music and business from Otterbein University, where I played the euphonium primarily. During my college years, I had the privilege of performing with various ensembles, including the Otterbein Concert Band, Wind Ensemble, Marching band, Jazz Band, pit orchestras, Ohio Private College Instrumental Conductors Association Honors Band and the Tuba and Euphonium Ensemble. I also played the baritone in the Central Ohio Brass Band and the Bexley Meadows band. I really enjoy the music that we play and hope to continue in the same tradition.

Here are a few things I'm currently working on:
