S. Barrett and to the members of the new City Council, which speaks for itself. The letter runs as follows :</p> <p>You have lived in Chillicothe long enough to know how much the citizens appreciate the summer band concerts, held in the City Park on warm summer nights; more so on Sunday evenings of the warm and sometimes hot weather during the summer from about the middle of June to the first Sunday in September.</p> <p>The city has given these before and handled them through the Service Department with a check from the city on a monthly basis.
