IN MEMORIAM.

Mary Elizabeth Stinson, was born near Waller, Ross county, Ohio, November 19th, 1829, and died in Chillicothe, Ohio, March 11th, 1908. Aged 78 years, 3 months and 22 days. January 19th, 1854, she was joined in marriage with James Warrey Dewey. To this union were born no children. About 1872 when the Presbyterian church was organized in Massieville, she united with that branch of the Christian church and continued a faithful member of the same to the day of her death.

She was faithful in all her church duties and always had a cheerful word for all with whom she came in contact. She was of a quiet and gentle disposition. She was somewhat a victim of disease the greater part of her life. In her youth, she was smitten with spinal trouble and for three years seemed to hover betwixt life and death. She endured her last illness which terminated in death for the space of six years.

During all this time she never murmured or complained of her sufferings, but seemed to be perfectly resigned to the will of the Heavenly Father. At the last moments she resigned her breathing and calmly and peacefully fell asleep as one taking repose in natural sleep without a pain or struggle. She leaves two brothers George W. Stinson of Eldorado Kan., and Archibald S. Stinson of Rochester, Ind., and one sister, Mrs. Thomas Huff of this city with quite a large connection of more distant relatives and friends to mourn her departure.

The funeral services were held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Huff on South Paint street, Rev. E. R. Bell officiating, after which the remains were laid to rest in the Hamilton cemetery to await the resurrection morn.
