The first is at the Hallsville cemetery at 11:30pm. The second is at the Adelphi cemetery at 1:30pm.

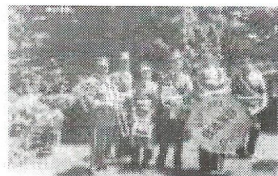
As additional information becomes available, we will send it on. Also, it will be posted on the Adelphi Band web site listed below.

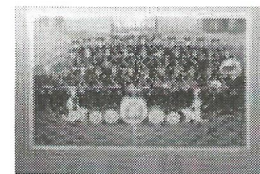

The following is information Glenn conveyed regarding upcoming engagements of the band.

Practice:

Practice is scheduled for Sunday, May 9, @ 6pm, at the Adelphi schoolhouse. This will be an outdoor practice, so plan accordingly. We have been advised there will be no electricity available. However, Sue Hinton said chairs would be provided.

Performances:

May 31 – Hallsville Cemetery, play @ 11:30pm. There will be no service at the United Methodist Church, and there will be no parade to the cemetery.

May 31 – Adelphi Cemetery, play @ 1:30pm

*** **Note:** You will notice that the Adelphi Cemetery job was usually on Sunday, the day before Memorial Day. This year they moved it to be on Memorial Day.

*** **Note 2:** Glenn noted winter uniforms should be worn for both events.

Looking ahead:

The below dates are for reference only. These are events which have traditionally been on our schedule. To my knowledge we have not yet been engaged to play at these, as some festivals are waiting to decide if they will try holding them in 2021.

June 9-12 is the **Laurelville Fireman's Festival**. Previous years we have played on Saturday for a 4:30pm concert, and in the parade @ 6pm. (This festival had been moved from late July to early June in 2020)

June 19-26 is the **Pickaway County Fair**. Previous years we have played on the first Saturday @ 12:30pm in the grandstand for the races, which would be June 19.

June 30 through July 4 is the **Ashville 4th of July celebration**. Previous years we have played in the parade on July 4th @ 11am, with a concert following.

July 23-31 is the **Lancaster Music Festival**. Previous years we have played at their Festival Fair Day, which this year is scheduled for Saturday, July 24.

August 7-14 is the **Ross County Fair**. Previous years we have played the first two days of the fair for horse racing @ 12:30pm. This year that would be on August 7 & 8.

October 10-16 is the **Fairfield County Fair**. In 2019 we played on Thursday of the fair, at 12:30pm, for the races. This year that would be October 14th.

October 20-23 is the **Circleville Pumpkin Show**. We usually play in the 8pm parade Friday evening. On Saturday we usually play a 6:30pm concert on the trailer, and in the 8pm parade. Those dates would be October 22 & 23.

Similar to last year, the Corona virus continues to make a significant impact on any type of gathering. Both state and local restrictions continue to be adjusted as deemed necessary. As a result, any item "scheduled" is subject to change as the event draws near. We will do our best to keep you informed.
