## LOCAL SCHOOLS CONCERT PLANS FINISHED

**ORCHESTRA, BAND AND GLEE CLUB JOIN IN GIVING PUBLIC EXHIBITION OF SKILL AT HIGH SCHOOL AUDITORIUM TUESDAY EVENING OF NEXT WEEK.**
