As you can imagine, the Corona virus has had a significant impact on any type of gathering this year, and has already made some serious dents in our customary performance schedule. At this point how many more changes occur is anyone's guess. When new or additional information is received it will be shared as quickly as possible.

Practices:

None are listed on the schedule. For some groups this might be an issue, but I suspect we are not one of those groups.

Performances:

May 24 – Adelphi Cemetery Memorial Services / CANCELLED May 25 – Hallsville UMC & Cemetery services / CANCELLED

June 6 - Laurelville Fireman's Festival: 4:30pm concert, 6:00pm parade / CANCELLED (This festival had been moved from late July to early June for 2020)

June 20 - 12:30pm at the Pickaway County Fair Grandstand – play for horse racing. (See note #1 below)

July 4 - 11am at Ashville for the July 4th parade. Concert following. (See note #2 below) July 25 – 12:45pm at the Lancaster Music Festival / CANCELLED

August 8 – 12:30pm for the Ross County Fair horse racing. August 9 – 12:30pm for the Ross County Fair horse racing.

October – Fairfield County Fair horse races, Lancaster.

Last year we played on Thursday of the fair, which this year would be October 15th. This listing will be updated later in the year.

October 23 – 8pm Circleville Pumpkin Show parade

October 24 - Circleville Pumpkin Show: 6:30pm concert on the trailer, 8pm parade

#1 *** At this point the Marion County Fair is the only county fair in Ohio that has cancelled for 2020. The Pickaway County Fair is "**on**" as far as is known now, but as with all gatherings, that continues to be under review. At this time the 2020 Pickaway County Fair is still scheduled to take place June 20-27. The Sr. Fair Board is working on an alternative plan should the state of Ohio not permit the fair to take place in it's full capacity as planned. A final decision will be made by the Sr. Fair Board at the June 8 monthly meeting and details/instructions shared immediately following that meeting.

#2 *** At this point the Ashville July 4th Festival is still "on". However, it should be noted that several central Ohio 4th of July festivals have already been cancelled, including the Columbus *Red, White, and Boom.* As reflected below, the Ashville Community Mens Club indicates their decision date is June 1:

Many people want to know if the 4th of July Celebration will take place this year.

At this time the Ashville Community Men's Club has continued to plan as if it will. We are also working to implement numerous safety measures for the comfort and safety of our volunteers and attendees.

Obviously this is all dependent on both state and local officials giving us approval to hold the event.

In order for us to meet our deadlines for printing, entertainers (headliner is TBA but he has recently had a song in the top 40 country billboard charts) and other vendors that provide services to the event, we need to make a final decision on June 1st and will base that decision on the information available to us at that time.
