The following is information Glenn conveyed regarding upcoming engagements of the band.

#### Practice:

Practice is scheduled for Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup>. It will be at 6:15pm in the shelter house of the Hallsville Community United Methodist Church, 8585 OH-180, Kingston, OH 45644. (This is the church where Memorial Day Services are usually held.) Rest room access is available, courtesy of the church. In case of inclement weather (rain), we will be allowed to practice inside. Chairs will be provided, but <u>bring your own stands</u>.

#### Performances:

**May 31** (Monday) – Hallsville Cemetery, play from 10:45am until 11:15am, followed by the program. After the program at the cemetery we will play for another 10-15 minutes, with Taps closing the ceremony.

\*\*\* Note 1: Chairs will be provided. You will have to bring your own stand.

\*\*\* **Note 2:** There will be no service at the United Methodist Church, and there will be no parade to the cemetery. There will only be the short service at the cemetery.

May 31 (Monday) – Adelphi Cemetery, play @ 1:30pm.

\*\*\* Note: Chairs will be provided. You will have to bring your own stand.

June 12 (Saturday) – Laurelville Fireman's Festival. Concert at 4:30pm, parade at 6pm.

The below dates are for <u>reference only</u>. These are events which have traditionally been on our schedule. To my knowledge we have not yet been engaged to play at these, as some festivals are waiting to decide if they will try holding them in 2021.

**June 19-26** is the **Pickaway County Fair**. Previous years we have played on the first Saturday @ 12:30pm in the grandstand for the races, which would be June 19. <u>They have not yet contacted Glenn about playing this year.</u>
