Unfortunately I just got a call tonight changing part of our Memorial Day schedule.

HALLSVILLE STAYS THE SAME:

At this point, the Hallsville Memorial Day observance in still on for Monday May 31, with us playing at 10:45 AM at the cemetery.

ADELPHI IS CHANGED:

I just a got a call tonight from the Adelphi coordinator.

Even though the Hallsville Coordinator and the Adelphi Coordinator were considerate enough to work out their times out together in order for the band to be able to make both services, the Adelphi schedule had not been checked with the VFW who runs the service.

That meeting just happened.

The VFW is a lot like our band based on personal schedules, age of their members, medical issues, etc., and they are unable to put together enough people to do the service on Monday.

Accordingly, the final information is:

The Adelphi service is CANCELLED for Monday May 31.

Adelphi is CONFIRMED that they are moving their service back to Sunday May 30.

The Adelphi Coordinator is asking if we can still put together a band for Sunday May 30 for their service.

If so: We would play in Adelphi at 1:30 The service would start at 2:00.

The Adelphi coordinator understands what that means for us and the distances you travel, and while he understands that I don't want to commit to the Adelphi service too but only be able to bring 3 people, the best I told him I could do is check with you individually to see what you are able to do.

I told him I could get him an answer by Friday night if the band could participate so that he would have enough time to get his promotional materials out. He was good with that time frame.
