

Adelphi festival starts Friday

The start of the ninth annual Adelphi Bologna Festival is just a few days away.

The festival begins with midway rides at 6 p.m. Friday, followed by the Queen Contest at 7:30 which will choose Miss Bologna, Little Miss Bologna and Little Mr. Bologna. The Queen Contest is open to any girl in Zane Trace High School or resident of Colerain Township. The Justice Family will provide round and square dancing until midnight Friday.

Saturday's activities begin at 11 a.m. with games for children on North Street beside the township hall. The Adelphi Band, celebrating its 100th year, will play from 2:30 to 3 in the afternoon, followed by the Bologna Parade with grand marshal Harry Armstrong, a former state senator. The Country Knights and Dewey Reinghauser will provide music in the evening.

Sunday's entertainment starts at 2 p.m. as the Adelphi Volunteer Fire Department sponsors its third annual talent contest. The contest, open to amateurs only, has a Thursday entry deadline. There are two age categories, 13 years old and under and 13 and over. Awards will be presented for first, second and third places. Gospel music will end Sunday's festivities, beginning at 6 p.m.
