## Memorial Day observances planned in region

The region's war dead will be honored Monday as Memorial Day observances are held in Chillicothe and the surrounding area.

The ceremony at the Veterans Administration Medical Center begins at 10 a.m. Post 757 of the American Legion will post the colors with patients at the hospital giving the Pledge of Allegiance, the general orders of the day and reading the Gettysburg Address.

Forrest Everhart from the Veterans Administration will deliver the speech and the patient band will perform.

The public may attend the ceremonies in the recreation hall at the hospital.

American Legion Posts 82 and 128 and the Civil War Roundtable will hold a ceremony at Grandview Cemetery at 9

a.m. The roundtable will meet at Joshua W. Still's grave in the cemetery.

A ceremony will begin at St. Margaret's Cemetery at 11 a.m. held by Post 108 of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and Disabled American Veterans No. 18.

A service will be held in Greenlawn Cemetery Soldier's Circle at 10:30 a.m. with American Legion posts 82 and 128.

**Clarkburg**  
A lunch will be served at the Browns Chapel Methodist Church in Clarkburg at 11 a.m.

The Frankfort American Legion Post 483 will conduct services at the Soldier's Circle in the Brown's Chapel Cemetery at 11:30 a.m. with the Adona High School Band.

**Frankfort**  
American Legion Post 483 will hold a service in the Frankfort Greenlawn Cemetery at 10 a.m. with the Rev. Robert K. Blaine as speaker.

**Londonderry**  
The Londonderry Friends Church and the Londonderry Methodist Church will hold a joint service at the Friend's Church at 10 a.m. The Rev. John Kirk of the Methodist Church will be the speaker and the service will be followed by a march through the cemetery by Southeastern High School band. In case of rain the service will be held on Wednesday.

**Hallsville**  
The Hallsville Memorial Day Service will begin at the Hallsville United Methodist Church at 10 a.m. with Louise Buchwalter Young as speaker.

After the service, the Adelpi Band will lead a procession to the Hallsville Cemetery where a wreath ceremony will be held and bouquets will be placed on the graves of all war veterans.

**Waverly**  
Waverly Merritt Post 142 of the American Legion will sponsor a parade at 10 a.m. in Waverly. Former Ohio Commander of the American Legion Roger Smith will be the speaker for a service at Evergreen Cemetery following the parade. Special recognition will be given to Vietnam veterans during the ceremony.

**Jackson**  
A parade will begin at 10 a.m. at the Memorial Building in Jackson with the Jackson High School Band. A service in Fairmount Cemetery will feature Bob Simpson as speaker.

At 9 a.m., a firing squad of American Legion members will travel to five county cemeteries to give salutes to veterans. Welo Channell, of Jackson, has placed 4,500 flags on the graves of county war veterans.

**Wellston**  
American Legion Post 371 will sponsor a parade in Wellston at 10 a.m. with the Wellston High School Band. Alec Blair, past Ohio Commander of the American Legion, will be the speaker in a service at Ridgewood Cemetery.
