Glass and ceramic museums to open next weekend

If this Memorial Day weekend is being spent working on the lawn or garden, you may want to go see something further away from home next weekend.

A new museum, the Degenhart Paperweight and Glass Museum in Cambridge, will open with a ribbon-cutting ceremony at 10 a.m. Saturday. A public open house will follow.

The museum, established by a bequest of Elizabeth Degenhart, will show American glassware from the mid-1800s.

Mrs. Degenhart and husband, John, were associated with the old Cambridge Glass Co. and in 1947 founded Crystal Art Glass.

The museum and shop are housed in the former Drake's Country Store at Interstate 77 and US-22. Hours through October will be 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday and noon to 5 p.m. Sunday.

DEDICATION of the newest state memorial, the East Liverpool Museum of Ceramics, will be at 10 a.m. Saturday.

In Akron, the Perkins Mansion and John Brown Home at Copley and Diagonal roads will have the Mutton Hill Antiques Fair from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday.

Hale Farm, north of Akron, will open a month-long quilt fair next Sunday.

Lancaster Old Car Club Festival will be held 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and next Sunday at the Fairfield County Fairgrounds.

Dayton Convention Center will have the International Festival Friday night, 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday and 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. next Sunday.

Ohio Spring Bluegrass Festival will start at 6 p.m. Friday, noon Saturday and Sunday at Badlands Campground in Peebles, southwest of Chillicothe. Don Reno, Hotmud Family and Muddy River Band will be there.

Norwalk Strawberry Festival in Huron County will be from noon to 11 p.m. today and Monday. Parade is 2 p.m. today.

At New Straitsville's 10th Moonshine Festival, moonshine will be made and then destroyed. Today's activities start at noon with five-string banjo contest at 7:30 p.m. and fiddle competition at 8:30. On Monday, the parade will be at 3 p.m., Adelphi Community Band at 4:30 and a rock group at 5:15. New Straitsville is on Ohio 93, south of Zanesville.

Utica's sixth Old Fashioned Ice Cream Festival will be across from Ye Olde Mill, a museum and ice cream shop, on Ohio 13, one mile south of Utica, which is south of Mount Vernon.

Ice-cream eating contests start at 4 p.m. today and 3:30 p.m. Monday. A micro-mini tractor pull will be at 10 a.m. Monday.

The fifth annual Great Miami River Festival is on from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. today and Monday at Dayton's Island Park. Capital City Ski Team from Madison, Wis., will perform three times daily. River float parade will be at 4 p.m. Monday.
