

Ceremonies Planned For Memorial Day

The Rev. Robert A. Long, pastor of the Tyler EUB Church, will be principal speaker for united Memorial Day services in Yocum Park at 1 p.m. Monday.

The Rev. Mr. Long currently serves as president of the Ross County Council of Churches.

Mrs. C. E. (Beryl) Overly said services will include a reading of General Logan's orders by Paul Francis, president of the Civil War Round Table; and Lincoln's "Gettysburg Address," by M. A. Moore. Mrs. Overly is chairman of the Central Memorial Committee which is in charge of the services in front of the Armory.

During the services, a Gold Star mother is to place a wreath on the World War I monument, and a geranium will be presented in honor of Spanish American War veterans.

Taps and a salute to the war dead by a composite firing squad commanded by Lt. William Mitchell of American Legion Post 82 will conclude the program.

Memorial services will be held Monday morning at a number of cemeteries with various VFW and American Legion Posts taking part. Services are scheduled at 9 a.m. Monday at both Floral Hills, Route 23 South, and Grandview Cemetery.

The American War Mothers, along with American Legion Post 787 will take part in ceremonies at Floral Hills while American Legion Post 62 is to participate at Grandview.

At 10 a.m., joint services will be conducted at St. Margaret's Cemetery, by the Disablers of American Veterans Post and the E. F. Glenn Post 108, Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Services at Greenlawn Cemetery will be at 10:30 a.m. with Daughters of Union Veterans and a representative for Spanish American War veterans participating.

Graves of General Sill and Major Mason are to be decorated at 8:30 a.m. by members of the Civil War Round Table.
