**CHILICOTHE DISTRICT CONFERENCE TO BE HELD THURSDAY, JUNE 16**

The spring session of the Chillicothe District Conference of the Methodist church will be held in Richmond Dale, Thursday, June 16, the second. The Richmond Dale church is a member church of the Chillicothe Larger Parish, the largest unit of its kind in the state. It will be remembered that the Chillicothe District was enlarged last September by Dr. R. O. McClure of the Adams District, succeeded Dr. James W. Blair as the superintendent. The church constituency of the present district is over 22,000. It embraces forty-eight charges and fifty ministers. It is representative of over one hundred and sixty individual churches. Richmond Dale church is the sponsor for the conference. The library is making extensive preparations to take care of the delegates that will come from the district. The church will serve both luncheon and dinner.
