The Corona virus continues to make changes to our anticipated summer events. The most recent casualty is the Ashville 4th of July Celebration. This has officially been **CANCELLED** for 2020. Their Facebook post to that effect is at the bottom of this email. I contacted Glenn this morning. Neither he nor Sue had been contacted yet with the official news, but were OK with me sending this information out as an email.

The next item on our calendar is playing for the races at the Pickaway County Fair on Saturday, June 20th. For those who don't participate in both, the Pumpkin Show Band, directed by Dave Winner, is scheduled to play at the races the next day, on Sunday, June 21st. I have 2 messages to share on this:

#1 - At the bottom is a Facebook post from the Pickaway County Fair from May 21st. This was in response to the news that the 2020 Ohio State Fair was cancelled. It identifies that decisions regarding going forward with the fair will be made at their meeting on June 8th.

#2 – Also on May 21st Dave Winner sent an email to the Pumpkin Show Band members covering several issues with their practice and performance plans. One sentence about the Pickaway County Fair possibly gave an indication how this is going to go:

"I just got off the phone with the guy in charge of our fair performance, and believes that the fair will probably be canceled because the State Fair just got canceled."

I don't have any further information about performance dates, but thought this should be shared as quickly as possible. There will not be a follow-up printed newsletter at this time.
