## Adelphi Bologna Fest gets under way tonight

ADELPHI — When the first ring of bologna is sold in the village tonight, the festival will have begun.

Highlights of this year's Adelphi Bologna Festival include a visit from a LifeFlight unit on Friday night and a get-together of old festival queens at the annual parade on Saturday night.

"It's going to make me feel old," said Lisa (Haughn) Arledge, a native of Adelphi who in 1972 was the first bologna queen. "But I think it's going to be fun."

Educational is what Chief Larry Goodman of the Adelphi Volunteer Fire Department hopes the visit from the LifeFlight helicopter from Grant Hospital will be for village residents.

His daughter and squad member, Janelle, said "If somebody got badly hurt, we'd have to call LifeFlight. We want to let people see what would happen."

Throughout the festival, the fire department and members of the Ladies Auxiliary, who sponsor the four days of events, will have their annual fish fry to raise funds for the department. The fundraiser also includes a general store where homemade items and bologna produced at the neighboring Laurelville Meat Packing Co. can be bought.

Carnival rides and games, four bands, a marching group and some square dancers will provide entertainment in addition to the traditional king and queen contests.

There are at least seven teen-age girls from the Zane Trace School District vying for the title of Miss Bologna this year. They are: Jada Berard, Heather Davidson, Michelle Renee Downs, Carrie Hertenstein, Stephany Karshner, Kiesha Vandagriff, and Debbie Darlene VanFossen.

Many other girls are vying for the titles of Junior Miss and Little Miss. And there are several boys in the running for Little Mister.
