It's no baloney — Bologna fest looms

ADELPHI — It's time for Adelphi to show its stuff again as the village readies for the 16th annual Adelphi Bologna Festival.

The event, which starts Wednesday and runs through Saturday, will include kings and queens, rides, games and a parade Saturday.

The festival will feature the village's famous bologna. Its German recipe was first used in Adelphi by Homer Fetherolf in 1954.

The company has changed hands several times, but the recipe has remained close to the original one.

This year, festival planners purchased 350 pounds of bologna to be sold.

And festival committee member Leona Barnes said they will have no problem selling all of it. Last year's 333 pounds were sold without fail, and people still were requesting more, she said.

Barnes said planners expect a big turnout, as usual, since the festival is Adelphi's biggest event of the year. The village fire department and rescue squad sponsor the fest.
