Friday

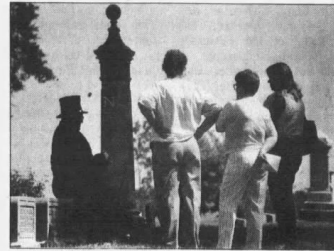
- 5 p.m. — Sounds of Latter Reign
