Elks, Service Groups To Sponsor Parade And Ceremony Wednesday

Chillicothe lodge of Elks, in preparing for Flag Day observance next Wednesday, June 14, is inviting all patriotic, fraternal and service organizations and any other interested groups or individuals to join in a parade and ceremony at the softball diamond in Yoctangee park on that evening.
