# Army Equipment Coming For Bond Rally Saturday

More than \$40,000 worth of army equipment will be paraded and displayed in Chillicothe Saturday, which has been designated as military equipment day for the Fifth War Loan drive.

Russell Savage, chairman of special events for the Fifth War Loan, announced that arrangements had been made with military authorities at Ft. Hayes, Columbus, for the following seven pieces of equipment to be sent here Saturday afternoon:

- 105 millimeter Howitzer, costing \$11,200.
- 37 millimeter anti-tank gun, costing \$2,200.
- 40 millimeter anti-aircraft (Bofor) gun, costing \$8,200.
- Personnel carrier, Half Track, costing \$8,200.
- Scout car, costing \$6,200.
- Amphibian Jeep, costing \$2,000.
- Jeep, costing \$1,400.

The army equipment, with eight men from Ft. Hayes in charge, is expected to arrive at the Bridge street bridge at 1:15 p. m.

With a police escort and the Adephi band, conducted by Arthur Hinton, the equipment will parade at 1:30, south on Bridge street to Main and west on Main street to the courthouse. There it will be displayed on the sidewalk through the afternoon and evening.

Parking will be prohibited in front of and on the side of the courthouse on War Bond drive
