Object of the display is to show Ross countians some of the uses to which war bond money is put and to stimulate the sale of bonds for the Fifth War Loan.

Bonds and stamps will be sold from a booth in front of the courthouse and women enlisted by Mrs. John Traquair, chairman of the women's division of the drive, will circulate through the crowd soliciting war bond orders.

Score will be kept on the bond sales made and results will be announced from time to time as amounts subscribed are sufficient to cover the cost of one or more of the pieces on display.

\$100,000 Goal

Goal of the bond sale for the day is \$100,000, Mr. Savage said, which would cover the cost of more than twice the amount of equipment expected.

Persons who come to see the display are being reminded to bring their check books so they can help subscribe the cost of the fighting tools.

A Junior Chamber of Commerce committee headed by Karl Bodenbender is arranging details of the display. Members of the committee include Ames Nelson, Maurice Schachne and Howard Rinehart.

Music by the Adelphi band, recordings made especially for the Fifth War Loan and brief personal appeals to buy more bonds will be intermingled on the program from the courthouse steps. The public address system of Carmine Mancino will be used.

The display will remain here until 8:30 or 9 p. m.
