Ohio Village will stay open evenings during the summer

COLUMBUS — The Ohio Historical Center and adjacent Ohio Village, I-71 and 17th Avenue, will offer summer evening hours most Fridays and Saturdays through Aug. 1, highlighted by 19th-century-style dinners, concerts and celebrations.

The center will be open 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. and the village will be open from 12:30 to 9 p.m. Both sites will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, July 18.

At 7:30 p.m. Fridays, July 17, 24 and 31, the village will offer The Great American Brass Band Concert Series, featuring old-fashioned outdoor musical performances. "Sunset Serenade," on July 17, will feature popular summer songs of the Victorian era, performed by the Adelphi Band, which has been in existence since 1880.

On July 24, the society's own Ohio Village Brass will play Stephen Foster tunes and 19th-century quadrilles and quicksteps during "The Victorian Gazebo."
