BIG BUS TURNS OVER; NONE HURT

Massieville Scene of Some Excite-
ment When Road Leviathan
Capsizes

Six passengers and the driver
of a Portsmouth-Chillicothe bus
had a narrow escape from serious
injury at noon today when the
machine, skidding on the paving as
it entered Massieville, turned
completely around and, going
over a ditch over-turned in the
yard of Thomas Huff. Despite the
fact the machine turned almost
completely over minor bruises
and scratches were all the injur-
ies recorded.

According to passengers the
bus, north bound and due here
shortly after 12 o'clock, came
down the grade and, when it laid
over to one side of the road on
meeting an approaching car,
worked into soft gravel at the side
of the paving and turned end for
end before capsizing.

One man had a cut on his fing-
er while another complained of a
slightly wrenched back. At taxi
was summoned from here and it
brought the passengers on to
Chillicothe while the machine, a
touring cor, after being righted,
was brought here for repairs.

Passengers declared that had
the machine been one of the big
sedans it would have been impos-
sible for any to have escaped in-
jury.
