This Sunday morning the musicians will assemble at Emmitt Chapel at 9 o'clock. They will play for the 9:15 church service. They will play next at the Centralized School, under the auspices of Crouse Chapel at 10:15. At 11:15 they will play at Hoptown. The Ladies Aid will serve them a noon luncheon. The band party will then go to the Huntington Centralized School and will play at 2:00. Following the church service a Sunday School will be organized by Mr. E. E. Townsend. The Sunday School will represent a township project. At 3:30 the band will play at Gline Chapel. Dr. George Weaver of the Ross County Parish will deliver the sermon. The Omega Ladies Aid will serve the band at 6:00. Then at 8 they will play again, this time being led by Mrs. Will Huff. On next Thursday, July 23 they will play at Meaco Park between the hours of 7 and nine in the evening. This will be the occasion of the Fish Fry that is being held there for the benefit of the parish church of Massesville. And on the following Sunday, July 26, they will play for the Sunday School of the First U. B. Church. Then they will play at Trinity at 10:30 for the church service.
