The Adelphi Band will give afternoon and evening concerts. Jake Noble of Chillicothe will present another of his chalk talks and musical program. An unusual act by trained monkeys will provide afternoon and evening entertainment combined with Zing and Zang clowns in the afternoon. Also at night, there will be an acrobatic act by the Thofas duo.

There will be industrial and commercial exhibits, also trap shooting and a horseshoe pitching tournament, with trophies awarded to the winners. The customary pony rides and various contests will engage the interest of the boys and girls, ending with the climbing of the greased pole.

Women of the community will serve a fish and chicken dinner, beginning at 4:30, and lunch will be served at the refreshment stands.
