

**Parade set for final night at Laurelville**

LAURELVILLE — Tonight's parade, to begin at 6:30, will be one of the final events of the Laurelville Firemen's Festival and centennial celebration.

The parade is to include four marching bands, with an 1889 hand-operated fire pumper from Johnstown. The marching bands are from Laurelville, Southeastern and Zane Trace High Schools, and the Adelphi Community Band.

Other events tonight will be a performance by the Adelphi band, and a beard judging contest at 8. To close out the program, a square dance will be held on the Foodtown parking lot.

Earlier in the day, a pony contest was to be staged at 1 at the Laurelville ball diamond. A bicycle parade was scheduled at 2:30, and a country and western music show at 3:30 p.m.

Friday night, Flippo the Clown of WBNS-TV, Columbus, gave a performance on the stage erected at Main and Franklin Streets. The activities concluded with a country and western music show at 9.

Fire Chief Lynn Summers, and other officials of the Fire Department sponsoring the festival, expect tonight's crowd to be the largest in the history of the festival.

Summers said ample parking space is available at the western approach to the community near the Arco service station on U. S. 56.
