

# 60th Clarksburg Field Day events set for Thursday

Preparations are underway for the 60th Annual Clarksburg Field Day to be held Thursday.

The annual event, sponsored by the Clarksburg United Methodist Church, will be held at the field day grounds, just east of the village on Ohio 138.

The event, usually held on the first Thursday in August, has been scheduled a week earlier this year, to avoid a conflict of scheduling with the Ross County Fair.

This year the program will include sky-divers, talent show, a bicentennial program, concerts, and other activities.

The event will begin at 1 p.m. Thursday and will continue until 11 p.m.

Qualifying round for the horseshoe pitching contest scheduled at 3 p.m. Sunday at the Field Day grounds.

Fish and chicken dinners will be served beginning at 4:40 p.m.

The schedule of events includes: Adelphi band concert, 1 p.m.; Amateur talent show, 2 p.m.; Adena High School band concert, 3 p.m.; Minutemen bicentennial program, 4 p.m.; children's games including a greased pole climb, 4:10 p.m.; tractor pull, 6 p.m.; Adelphi

band concert, 5:30 p.m.; Randy Miller, magician, 6:30; Barber shop quartet, 7 p.m.; Royalties, gospel music concert; 8 p.m.; Minutemen, 9 p.m.; square dance exhibition 9:30 p.m.

Sky divers from Rickenbacker Air Force Base will present three jumps during the afternoon. The times will be announced from the stage.

Trap shooting will begin at 10 a.m. and will last to dark. Pony rides and horseshoe-pitching will continue throughout the day and evening.
