Crew prepares grounds for Clarksburg Field Day

CLARKSBURG — Members of a grounds crew for the Clarksburg Field Day began today rearing the United Methodist Church grounds for the annual event Thursday.

According to reports from grounds Chairman Richard Hiser, crew members were installing stoves and refrigerators in food booths and buildings. Other members were busy mowing grass on the lawn where nearly 3,000 persons are expected to gather for the all-day event.

Grounds Improve

Several improvements have been made to the grounds this year, Hiser indicated. The cooking area where fish and chicken are fried for the dinner menu has been enclosed with screen.

A new three-foot wide walkway has been laid with blacktop paving around the dinner stands.

Hiser also reported the Route 138 approach to the field day grounds from Clarksburg has been improved. He noted, there will be "plenty of free parking space" available on the grounds.

The activities get underway at 10 a.m. with trapshooting and horseshoe pitching contests. Other highlights include a 2:45 p.m. performance by the Senior Citizens Band of Columbus, and afternoon and evening concerts by the Adelphi Band.

Garden Tractor Pull

A new contest — a garden tractor pull — has been added this year, according to Bennett Junk, general chairman. That contest will begin at 6 p.m. under the direction of the Buckeye Garden Tractor Pullers, a Clarksburg area group.

The evening program includes country music by Mike Cutright and the Rhythm Masters from the Richmond Dale area, at 8:15 p.m., and the Bolles Brothers, of Chillicothe, at 8:45 p.m.

Pony rides, games and contests are planned for the youngsters throughout the day, and dinner serving will start at 4:30 p.m.
