

New contests, events added for Clarksburg Field Day

CLARKSBURG— Several new contests and events have been added this year to the more traditional Clarksburg Field Day activities next Thursday.

One new event will be a performance by Dallas G. Wittgenfield, appearing as Thunderchicken, the Sky-diving Clown. His program will include sky diving, a ping pong ball drop, magic act, hot air balloon ascension and tethered balloon rides for children.

New contests include Paul Bunyan events—log sawing and wood chopping; needle threading, potato peeling, and seven categories of beard and mustache growing contests.

The Adelphi Band will present afternoon and evening

concerts. The band has participated in the Field Day program for the last 45 years and possibly longer.

This year's Field Day will be the sixty-first. The event is sponsored by the United Methodist Church, and is held in a grove.

The event also will feature the traditional trap shoot, beginning at 10 a.m. horseshoe pitching and displays of antique farm machinery, household crafts and antiques. There also will be several food and refreshment booths. Dinners will be served beginning at 4:30 p.m.
