Clarksburg Field Day To Be Aug. 4

CLARKSBURG — Plans are nearing completion for the Clarksburg Field Day to be held Thursday, Aug. 4, in Hurst's Grove, one-quarter mile east of Clarksburg on Route 138. This is the 41st event sponsored annually by the Clarksburg Methodist Church and each year attracts large crowds, many coming from a distance.

Robert Drew and Solon Graham are serving as general co-chairmen and Bennett Junk is chairman of the program committee.

Many attractions are planned for the day-long affair, starting with a tractor pulling contest at 10:30 a. m. There will be five separate classes, with prize money and trophies being awarded.

Trap shooting will start at noon, the Adelphi Band will present afternoon and evening concerts, and there will be athletic events for young and old. Rides on ponies and in Davy Crockett mule carts will be provided for the children.

Highlights of the evening entertainment will be a program presented by members of the Midwestern Hayride group, radio and television entertainers. The program will begin at 8 p. m. and will feature Rudy Hanson, the Pine Mountain Boys, and Winnie Mae and Betty.

Lunch will be served during the day at refreshment stands, and a fish and chicken dinner will be served in the evening. Serving will begin at 4:30. Commercial exhibits are invited, with free space provided.
