Field Day Thursday Clarksburg residents busy

CLARKSBURG—Just about everyone in Clarksburg is working today to prepare for the 60th annual Clarksburg Field Day, Thursday, according to Lucille McDonald, entertainment committee chairman.

She said the event is sponsored by the Clarksburg United Methodist Church, but just about everyone in the village participates in preparing for the event.

About 600-800 pounds of hamburgers are being prepared today, along with chickens and fish which will be cooked Thursday at the field day grounds, just east of the village on Ohio 138. Pies, cakes and vegetables also are being prepared, she said.

Mrs. McDonald said about 1,000 dinners usually are served during the annual event.

The field day, usually held on the first Thursday in August, has been scheduled a week earlier this year, to avoid a conflict of scheduling with the Ross County Fair.

This year the program will include skydivers, a talent show, a bicentennial program, concerts and other activities.

The event will begin at 1 p.m. and will continue until 11 p.m.

The dinners will be served beginning at 4:40 p.m.

The schedule of events includes an Adelphi band concert, 1 p.m.; amateur talent show, 2 p.m.; Adena High School band concert, 3 p.m.; Minutemen bicentennial program, 4 p.m.; children's games, 4:10 p.m.; a garden tractor pull, 6 p.m.; Adelphi band concert 5:30 p.m.; magic

act, 6:30 p.m.; barber shop quartet, 7 p.m.; gospel music concert, 8 p.m.; Minutemen demonstration, 9 p.m.; and square dance exhibition at 9:30 p.m.

Skydivers from Rickenbacker Air Force Base will present three parachute jumps during the afternoon. The times will be announced from the stage.

Trapshooting will begin at 10 a.m., and will last to dark. Pony rides and horseback-riding will continue throughout the day and evening.
