Annual Field Day At Clarksburg To Be Held Aug. 6

Balloon Ascension, television and radio entertainers will be outstanding features at the Clarksburg Field Day Thursday in Hurst's grove, one-half mile east of Clarksburg.

Sponsored annually by the Methodist Church, this event has been held more than 35 years and attended by thousands each year.

This year's event promises to be bigger and better than ever before. An extensive program has been scheduled by the program committee highlighted by a balloon ascension, the first in this part of Ohio in 30 years.

Music will be furnished again this year, by the well known Adelphi Band. There will be trapshooting, contests of various kinds and other athletic events for both young and old. Free space will be provided for all commercial exhibits.

Fish and chicken dinners will be served in the evening beginning at 4:30 p. m. and lunch will be served throughout the day.
