## Clarksburg Gets Ready for Field Day

CLARKSBURG — Hurst's Grove, a quarter miles east of here, is rapidly being readied for Thursday's 42nd annual Clarksburg Field Day. The large eating pavillion, almost completely wrecked last year when a huge 180-year old tree toppled during a storm, has been repaired. Other buildings and the grounds have been made ready and electrical wiring installed. More than a score of commercial exhibits will be on hand, provided by various business establishments of the area. Activities get underway at 10:30 a.m. Thursday with a tractor pulling contest. A trap shoot follows at 11:30 and a lunch is planned for 12:30 at the stands. Throughout the day, pony rides will be available for the children. The annual horse pulling contest is slated for 1 p.m., a concert by the Adelphi Community band and a girls' quartet and the address of welcome by the Rev. DeLoss Smith at 2:30. Children's stunt, set for 3:30 p.m., will be climaxed by a greased pole climbing contest. Serving of dinner is set for 4:30 p.m. and the evening program will get underway at 7:30 p.m. with a second concert by the Adelphi band. Billy Scott and Helen Harris will be featured at 8 p.m. and Roxanne will present a dance routine at 8:30. Concluding the day's events will be Duncan the Magician and a concert by the Vet's Male Quartette.
