CLARKSBURG — For 70 years, people in Clarksburg have gathered each summer on village grounds to share a little gossip and a lot of entertainment. It's that time again.

Thursday, villagers will meet on the Field Day grounds along Ohio 138, a quarter-mile east of the village. Field Day, sponsored by the Clarksburg United Methodist Church, often serves as a homecoming for former village residents.

Ralph Goff, chairman, said old-time entertainment is planned, including trap shooting, horseshoe pitching and an all-day flea market. Old-fashioned children's games will provide entertainment in the afternoon.
