





Record attendance is expected at Otterbein-Lebanon's 25th annual Fish Fry, Open House and Arts & Crafts Festival on Saturday, July 31.




While the "all you can eat" fish dinner was the original center-piece of the annual event, the occasion has always included an arts and crafts festival in the Hobby Lobby.
