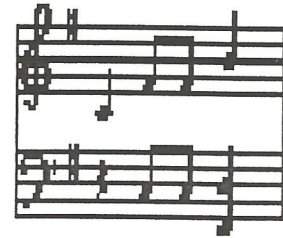


## LARGE CROWD ANTICIPATED AT 25TH ANNUAL FISH FRY

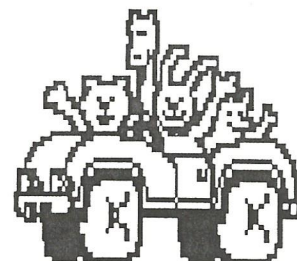
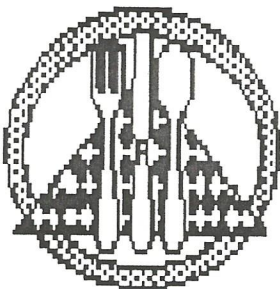
While the "all you can eat" fish dinner was the original center-piece of the annual event, the occasion has always included an arts and crafts festival in the Hobby Lobby.

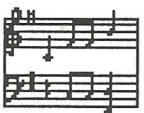
