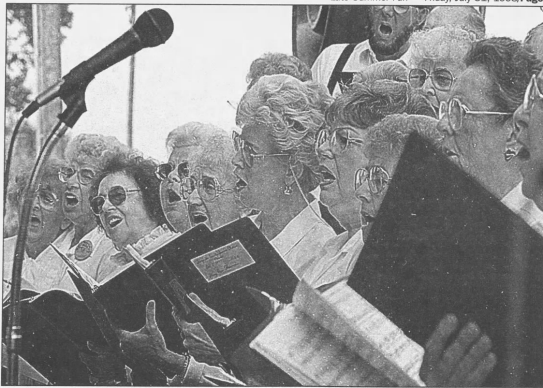
At 2 p.m., Mountain Moms will take apart a 1918 Ford Model T and reassemble it in 15 minutes or less so it is driveable.
