Both attachments are in Adobe format, so they should open easily. If you experience problems with that please let me know.

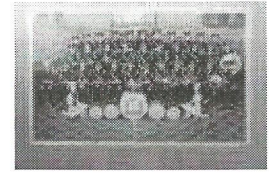

Reminders:

If you have convinced any musicians to sit in with us at this event, let me know at least 2 days before the event so that I can make sure that I can have the music for them. I don't keep spare folders, so I print them off as they are needed.

Also, as you look through your music in prep for the 24th, if you see that your folder has an incorrect part for your instrument (a 2nd part instead of a 1st, an Eb Sax instead of a Euphonium....yes...it happened.... etc) just let me know. I have pretty much found, and basically organized, all the stash of all the spare music, and I might be able to change out the incorrect music.

I will always have printed copies of the concert list with me at the event. So, if you show up without one, just remind me. I usually catch the musicians who show up first to give them a copy, but I may become distracted by shiny stuff later on and not remember to give a copy
