Clarksburg's 'Field Day' Set Thursday

CLARKSBURG — Clarksburg's 51st annual Field Day, sponsored by the Methodist Church, will be held Thursday in the Methodist Grove on Ohio 138, a half mile east of the village.

Many attractions have been planned for all day and evening including a tractor - pulling contest under auspices of the State Tractor - Pulling Association, horseshoe pitching for prizes and trophies, trap shooting, pony rides and contests for boys and girls ending with the greased pole.

The Adelphi Band will highlight the afternoon program, while the Adena High School Band will be featured in the early evening. There will also be music by the Ranch Hands and a varied program of song, dance and special features by the Tune Mates, a widely known group of Ohio State University students.

Industrial exhibits are scheduled.

Lunch will be served during the day at refreshment stands and a fish and chicken dinner will be served in the evening beginning at 4:30.
